

Work Opportunity Tax Credit Statistics for Maryland

In 2020 the state of Maryland issued **31,863** Work Opportunity Tax Credit certifications.


The Work Opportunity Tax Credit, known as WOTC, is a federal tax credit available to employers who hire individuals from target groups, that include qualified Veterans, individuals on food stamps and more.

The Work Opportunity Tax Credit is available throughout the United States, and in 2020 it was worth approximately \$3.8 Billion dollars to employers. **1,620,806** total Work Opportunity Tax Credits were issued in the United States in 2020. WOTC was renewed for five years in 2020, and is active through 12/31/2025.

Nationwide, Maryland issued 1.97% of WOTC Tax Credits in 2020.

Work Opportunity Tax Credits

The Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) is a Federal tax credit incentive available to employers who hire individuals from certain target groups that have historically faced significant barriers to employment.

Employers claimed \$4.9 billion in tax credits in 2020 from the WOTC program. Between 10-15% of all new hires may qualify.

How Much Can I Save?

Employers can earn a tax credit from \$4,000 to \$9,600 per eligible employee, depending on the target group of the new employee and number of hours worked in the first year. Employers must hire at least 100 employees in the first year of employment.

WOTC Example Savings:

- Company Size: 500 employees
- Number of Annual New Hires: 100
- Qualifying Percentage: 15%
- Average Tax Credit: \$2,400
- Employer Credit: \$240,000

- Qualified Veterans
- SNAP (Food Stamp) Recipients
- TANF Recipients (Long/Short term)
- Ex-Felons
- Designated Community Residents
- Vocational Rehabilitation Referrals
- Summer Youth Employees
- VET Reentry
- Long-Term Unemployed
